After I started cosplaying, I saved everything: Blades from an old wooden fan, metal collapsing tubing from repairing the dryer, foam packing materials. All of this and everything else around the house might just be what you are looking for.

BASIC SUPPLIES:

- Superglue
- A few needles
- Seam ripper
- Variety of thread – at least white and black
- Xacto Knife
- Scissors
- Duct Tape
- Tape Measure
- Pins
- Craft Pliers

OPTIONAL:

- Sewing Machine
- Tacky Glue
(for use on things you might want to reuse)
- Toaster Oven
(cooking crafty parts)
- Trimmings – ribbon, lace, jewels, buttons
- Flexi Foam
- Christmas Ornaments

EMERGENCY KIT

Needle, small selection of thread, tape, glue, pins

(great sources for different shiny parts of your costumes)
